SUMMARY/BRIEF OVERVIEW OF THE SERVICE

Well-appointed rooms with views of the historical town.

Window drapes are of a contemporary design with modern tones to compliment the colour scheme of the room. Drapes are double backed to provide temperature control. Sheers provide privacy. The room has natural light which is provided via large mid floor to ceiling windows with views of landscaped gardens/ parklands. Floors are carpeted with tactile carpet recommended for its superior noise reducing and insulating qualities. This room has a private en-suite, grab rails and emergency call bell. Amenities available in this room include an already connected telephone and internet service, picture rails, nurse call points, wide access doors and a reverse cycle air-conditioner with adjustable temperature controls.
